Barry A. Ritzler, PhD, ABPP (from: www.rorschachtraining.com)

Barry Ritzler, PhD, is Professor of Psychology at Long Island University in New York City. His specialty is personality assessment; and in addition to working with doctoral students, he teaches graduate courses in Personality Assessment and Research Design. He earned his doctoral degree from Wayne State University in Detroit, Michigan and completed a post doctoral fellowship at Yale University. For many years he was the Director of Clinical Training at the University of Southern Mississippi and Fairleigh Dickinson University in New Jersey. Dr Ritzler currently lectures on the Rorschach method at Rutgers University in New Jersey and Yeshiva and Columbia Universities in New York City.

For more than fifteen years he was a Senior Faculty Member of Rorschach Workshops and conducted workshops on the administration and interpretation of the Rorschach Comprehensive System. He served as president of the Society for Personality Assessment (SPA) from 1995 - 1997. Dr. Ritzler has been an invited speaker at international seminars in various countries, including Israel, Argentina, Italy, Canada, Spain, and Brazil. He has published ten book chapters and over 75 articles in scientific peer reviewed journals. In addition, he co-authored a book, *The Quest for the Nazi Personality*, 1996. Currently, he is a consulting editor of the *Journal of Personality Assessment*, and serves as an editorial consultant for several other psychology journals.
