#### *Morning:*

Updating our knowledge of the Rorschach Comprehensive System

We will present some recent research on the Rorschach, including replications of seminal studies of J. Exner, such as eye movement tracking and card structures (Z scores), EB styles and the LAD (logical analysis device), emotion and the colour determinant, impact of colours on mediation processes, a new calculation of EB.

#### *Afternoon*

Presentation of the CHESSSS Excel application for computing protocols, multiple scorings, structural summaries and constructing databases. Illustration with a case and datasets.

Anne Andronikof, Ph.D. is currently professor of Psychopathology and Head of the Research Center IPSe at Paris West University (France). Current research topics are the psychometric properties of the Rorschach test, the role of self-image and narcissism in health processes, psychopathology of violent behaviours. She is also a clinical psychologist, presently focusing on psychology assessment in forensic settings and child and adolescent conduct disorders. Past president of the International Society of the Rorschach and Projective Methods (ISR), President of the Comprehensive System International Rorschach Association (CSIRA), Curator of the Hermann Rorschach Archives and Museum (HRAM), fellow member of the Society for Personality Assessment, Honorary Editor of the international journal *Rorschachiana*, referee for the Italian Ministry of Education, University and Research (MIUR).
